

Big Administration Changes In D.C.A.

MELBOURNE, May 13.— Important administration changes in the Department of Civil Aviation were announced today by the Director-General (Air-Marshal Sir Richard Williams).

Mr. R. W. Gross, who has been regional director of the NT for the past two years, has been appointed director of airways operations at the Melbourne head-office and he will be succeeded by Mr. F. W. Collopy, senior supervisor of air-traffic control in the Victorian-Tasmanian region.

Mr. V. Rule, previously assistant superintendent of the air-traffic control branch, will become co-ordinator of operational planning and Mr. R. F. Edy, the senior supervisor area control at the traffic control branch will be superintendent of aeronautical information services.
